Whereas, certain of the amended rules allow for the Court to enter orders excepting cases and proceedings from the operation of said amended rules; and


Other good cause appearing;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT, except as otherwise ordered by the Court, the provisions of amended F.R.C.P. 26 (a) (1) - (4) concerning requirements for disclosure of information, and F.R.C.P. 26 (f) concerning discovery meetings shall not be applicable in any contested matter or adversary proceeding pending or hereafter filed in this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT, except as otherwise ordered by the Court, the provisions of District of Idaho Local Rule 26.2 concerning pretrial disclosure of information shall also not be applicable in any contested matter or adversary proceeding pending or hereafter filed in this Court.
