It further appearing that the Honorable Terry L. Myers has been appointed and commenced service as a United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Idaho effective August 4, 1998; and

It further appearing that it is necessary to assign responsibility for the cases pending and to be filed in this District to the active Bankruptcy Judges;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. All bankruptcy cases, and all adversary proceedings arising therein or related thereto, pending on July 31, 1998 and previously assigned to Judge Hagan shall be and are hereby assigned to Judge Myers for all purposes and proceedings EXCEPT those bankruptcy cases and adversary proceedings identified on Exhibit "A" attached to this Order. All other bankruptcy cases, and all adversary proceedings arising therein or related thereto, pending on July 31, 1998, shall be and are hereby assigned to Chief Judge Pappas for all purposes and proceedings.

- 2. All bankruptcy cases, and all adversary proceedings arising therein or related thereto, filed with this Court on or after July 31, 1998, wherein the debtor(s) resides in the following counties shall be assigned to Judge Myers for all purposes and proceedings: Benewah, Bonner, Boundary, Clearwater, Idaho, Kootenai, Latah, Lewis, Nez Perce and Shoshone.
- 3. All bankruptcy cases, and all adversary proceedings arising therein or related thereto, to be filed with this Court on or after July 31, 1998, wherein the debtor(s) resides in the following counties shall be assigned to Chief Judge Pappas for all purposes and proceedings: Bannock, Bear Lake, Bingham, Blaine, Bonneville, Butte, Camas, Caribou, Cassia, Clark, Custer, Franklin, Fremont, Gooding, Jefferson, Jerome, Lemhi, Lincoln, Madison, Minidoka, Oneida, Power, Teton and Twin Falls.
- 4. All bankruptcy cases, and any adversary proceedings arising therein or related thereto, wherein the debtor(s) resides in the following counties shall be randomly assigned by the Clerk to either Chief Judge Pappas or Judge Myers, for all purposes and proceedings, in such proportion as the Chief Bankruptcy Judge shall from time to time instruct the Clerk: Ada, Adams, Boise, Canyon, Elmore, Gem, Owyhee, Payette, Valley, Washington (and referred Malheur County Oregon cases).
